What do I pay for Waste Services?

How are Waste Services billed?

Waste services are billed on your monthly water bill. Payment is due on the 15th of the month. Please contact Village Hall at (618)248-5154 with any questions or if you do not receive a bill.

What is the Waste Services schedule?

Tuesday is garbage pick up day, **Wednesday** is yard waste pick up day and **Friday** is recycling pick up day.

Do I need to buy garbage and recycling containers?

No. The Village will provide you with one (1) garbage cart and one (1) recycling cart. Both carts are the property of the Village. NOTE: Additional garbage (\$50) and recycle (\$44) carts may be purchased at the Village Hall.

Do I need to buy yard waste containers?

Yes. You must provide your own yard waste containers.

What materials are picked up on Wednesday's yard waste day?

Yard Waste shall mean all leaf and yard trimmings, small bundled twigs and branches (less than 4 inches in diameter and less than 4 feet long). **Excluded Items:** Yard waste in plastic bags, yard waste mixed with garbage, bulky roots, bushes, dirt, and all yard waste generated from commercial businesses, such as lawn care companies.

How is Wednesday's yard waste picked up?

You may set out yard waste containers no earlier than Tuesday evening, but no later than 6:00 a.m. Wednesday morning. You must remove yard waste containers from the curb no later than Wednesday evening. Yard waste may be placed in either yard waste containers or Kraft brown paper bags. Yard Waste containers must be marked with a red "X". All yard waste must fit in the containers or Kraft bags and no heavier than 50 lbs. Yard waste will **only** be picked up from March 15 to December 15.

What materials are picked up on Tuesday's garbage day?

Garbage shall mean all waste generated within a normal household. **Excluded Items:** Residue from construction / remodeling, roofing, siding, lumber, oil, grease, hazardous materials, paint, hot ashes, batteries, tires, televisions, computers, monitors, printers, video game consoles, DVRs, VCRs, and similar electronic equipment (See E-Recycle information).

When are bulky garbage items picked up?

Items that cannot fit in the provided cart are considered bulky items may be set out with garbage carts for Tuesday pick up. Bulky items include: Furniture, mattress/box springs, carpet and padding (rolled, cut into pieces no longer than 4 feet, tied or taped and no heavier than 50 pounds each). **Excluded Items:** Residue from construction/remodeling, roofing, siding, lumber, tires, oil, grease, and paint.

How is Tuesday's garbage picked up?

Set out your provided cart no earlier than Monday evening, but no later than 6:00 a.m. Tuesday morning. Carts must be removed from the curb no later than Tuesday evening. All garbage must fit in the provided cart.

Electronics will no longer be picked up as garbage or recycling!

The following may be taken to the Albers Maintenance Shed, 301 North Hill Street for recycling: Printers / facsimile machines, computers / small servers, keyboards / mice, VCRs / DVDs / digital music players, video game consoles, scanners, digital converter boxes, and cable / satellite receivers. Items may also be taken to Eagle Recycling (226-3478), 26099 Wiedle Road, Shattuc, IL 62231 or other Illinois EPA approved site.

TV's are NOT ACCEPTED! DO NOT leave TV's at the Albers Maintenance Shed! A complete listing of E-Recycle sites, including those accepting TV's, is available at epadata.epa.state.il.us/land/eWaste/collection-sites.asp.

What materials are picked up on Friday's recycling day?

Recycling shall mean aluminum, tin cans, glass bottles (green, amber, clear), plastic milk and soda bottles (#1 and #2), detergent bottles, bleach bottles, etc. (Excluding #5), corrugated cardboard, mixed office paper, junk mail, newspaper, chipboard, magazines and catalogs. **Excluded Items:** Household appliances (see below), contaminated packaging (pizza boxes, food wrappers, containers previously containing products such as cooking / motor oil), Styrofoam products, disposable diapers, plastic grocery bags, residue from construction/remodeling, roofing, siding, lumber, tires, oil, grease, and paint.

When are household appliances picked up? Household appliances scheduled by calling Village Hall (248-5154) anytime. Household appliances shall mean refrigerators, stoves, freezers, hot water heaters / softeners, dishwashers, air-conditioners, furnaces, boilers, washers, and dryers.

How is Friday's recycling picked up?

Set out your provided cart no earlier than Thursday evening, but no later than 6:00 a.m. Friday morning. Carts must be removed from the curb no later than Friday evening. All recycling must fit in the provided cart.

Who do I call when a pickup is missed?

Call the Village Hall (248-5154) or Waste Management (800-989-2783). Your waste should be picked up within 48 hours.

Are dumpsters available?

Yes. Dumpsters are available for Village waste services customers at the Village Maintenance Yard on North Hill Street.

What holidays affect service?

Waste Management recognizes New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day as holidays. If the holiday is on or before your scheduled pick up day in the holiday week, your pick up day for that week will be one (1) day late.

TUESDAY is GARBAGE DAY.

Garbage shall mean all waste generated within a normal household.

Excluded Items:

- E-Recycle Items (See Below)
- Tires / Batteries
- Oil / Grease
- Paint / Hazardous materials
- Hot ashes
- Siding / Roofing
- Lumber
- Residue from construction debris / remodeling

Note: Tonnies Hardware and Rental provides FREE recycling of all types of batteries, and cellular phones.

WEDNESDAY is YARD WASTE DAY.

Yard waste may be placed in either **Yard waste containers or Kraft brown paper bags no heavier than 50 lbs.** Yard Waste containers must be marked with a red "X". Yard waste will be picked up bi-weekly from **March 15 to December 15**. Please call Village Hall (618-248-5154) with questions.

Yard Waste shall mean:

- All leaf and yard trimmings
- Small bundled twigs and branches (less than 4 inches in diameter and less than 4 feet long).

Excluded items:

- Yard waste in plastic bags
- Yard waste mixed with trash
- Bulky roots, bushes, and dirt
- Yard waste generated from commercial businesses, such as lawn care companies

NOTE: Leaves, grass and small limbs may be disposed of at the north-west corner of JC Park.

FRIDAY is RECYCLING DAY.

Recycling shall mean:

- Glass bottles (green, amber, clear)
- Plastic milk and soda bottles (#1 and #2)
- Colored HDPE - Detergent bottles, bleach bottles, etc. (Excluding #5)
- Paper products: Corrugated cardboard, mixed office paper, junk mail, newspaper, chipboard, magazines and catalogs.
- Aluminum and tin cans

Excluded Items:

- Food contaminated packaging
- Containers previously containing products such as cooking or motor oil
- Styrofoam products
- Disposable diapers
- Plastic grocery bags
- Residue from construction/remodeling
- Residue from construction/remodeling
- Siding / Roofing
- Lumber
- Tires
- Oil / Grease
- Paint

NOTE: Tonnies Hardware provides FREE recycling of waste motor oil, all rechargeable batteries, and cell phones.

HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES RECYCLING

Advance notice is REQUIRED! Call Village Hall (618-248-5154) to schedule appliance pick up.

Appliances shall mean: Refrigerators, stoves, freezers, hot water heaters/softeners, dishwashers, air-conditioners, furnaces, boilers, washers and dryers.

E-RECYCLE

E-Recycle shall mean:

- Printers / Facsimile machines
- Computers / small servers
- Keyboards / mice
- VCRs / DVDs
- Digital music players
- Video game consoles
- Scanners
- Digital converter boxes
- Cable / Satellite receivers

E-Recycle may be taken to the Albers Maintenance Shed, 301 North Hill Street or any IL-EPA approved site.

TV's are NOT ACCEPTED! DO NOT leave TV's at the Albers Maintenance Shed! A complete listing of E-Recycle sites, including those accepting TV's, is available at epadata.epa.state.il.us/land/eWaste/collection-sites.asp.
